Red Sea Splits in Re-creation of the Passover Exodus at the Jewish Children's Museum

New York, March 5 -- Beginning on March 5, and running through April 17, the only Jewish Children's Museum in the world will bring to life in a fully interactive show, the biblical account of the Jewish slavery in Egypt. This event will coincide with the Passover season, which commemorates the Jews' slavery in Egypt and subsequent journey to freedom. Exodus is located on the fourth floor of the Jewish Children's Museum, 792 Eastern Parkway, in Brooklyn, NY.

Exodus is designed to give people – particularly children – a peek into the colorful history of the Jewish people, not only through hearing about it, but by actually experiencing it. The show begins with participants climbing into a "time machine" for the journey back into ancient Egypt. Upon "arrival" visitors make stops in Pharaoh's palace to witness the Ten Plagues, watch Moses demand of Pharaoh: "Let my people go!," walk through the splitting sea and cross the desert to receive the Ten Commandments at Mount Sinai. Finally, they have the opportunity to make and bake their very own matzah. No detail is overlooked in this spectacular voyage through history.
